Please give at least 48 business hours' notice if you need to cancel your appointment, otherwise you may incur a fee.

If your appointment time becomes inconvenient for you, we are always happy to change it if you provide us with two business days' notice. This allows us to schedule in a patient who may be in urgent need of our care.

We are situated on Broad Street, right opposite the cathedral, in Hereford's city centre. You will find us next to the old library on the fourth floor or Broadway House.

DENTAL EMERGENCIES

If you are suffering with a dental emergency please ring our Surgery number 01432 266899 as normal. During our normal opening hours we will always endeavour to book you in to see the Dentist the same day if you are in pain.

Out of hours, our telephone message provides the Emergency number and relevant details for our outof-hours service which is a rota system shared by a number of private practices in Hereford.

If you are a Denplan patient you will need to have your Denplan number and there will be a call out charge of £20 depending on your scheme.

If you pay-as-you-go then there will be a call out charge of £180 and any emergency treatment required may be charged at £40 per 15 minutes.

If you are not in your local area and a dental emergency happens always phone the relevant Denplan emergency number.
